For the four months ending October 31, 2019 our revenue was \$400,063.82. Our expenses for October was \$89,732.52. The expenses for the four months ending October 31, 2019 was \$352,152.92. Mike Kerns states that we have a profit of \$47,911.90 ending the four months of October 31, 2019. Mike states we are right on line to exceed the budget on revenue by 3%. Also states that the water and sewer rates will be increase in January. Mike states that all look promising. Mike asks if there are any question or comments.

A. REVIEW BID TABULATION WITH ROBERT VAUGHAN.

He states that there were plenty of interest in the project, and ten contractors sent a bid. Review in the bid tabulation there were bids from \$49,000 thousand all the way up to \$199,000. The lowest bid was from Black Oak Construction, for \$49,975.20, but did not have bid security with their bond. They also did not meet qualifications, no sewer experience. The second bid was from Bates Instrumentation, LLC they have bid security. Mr. Vaughan states that he did speak with our attorney Pat Layden, and everything checks out. Pat Layden states that you don't have to take the lowest bid. And its legal to accept a different bid.
