COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES  
JUNE 16, 2019

1. Bobby Watkins called the meeting to order.
2. Julia Casey, City Clerk called roll. Bobby Watkins – Present, Tommy Walker – Present, Connie Poole – Present, Jason Wagnon – Present, Daulfin Bennett – Present.
3. PRAYER AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE
4. CONSIDER AND ACT TO APPROVE THE MINUTES OF THE MAY 21, 2019 COUNCIL MEETING. Mayor Watkins asks for a motion. Daulfin Bennett makes the motion. Jason Wagnon seconds the motion. Mayor Watkins calls for a vote. Daulfin Bennett – yes, Jason Wagnon – yes, Connie Poole – yes, Tommy Walker – yes. Motion to approve minutes passes.
5. CONSIDER AND ACT TO APPROVE THE CLAIMS. Mayor Watkins asks for a motion. Jason Wagnon makes a motion. Connie Poole seconds the motion. Mayor Watkins calls for a vote. Daulfin Bennett – yes, Jason Wagnon – yes, Connie Poole – yes, Tommy Walker - yes. Motion to approve claims passes.
6. REVIEW CITY OF KREBS FINANCIAL STATEMENT WITH MIKE KERN. Mike Kern is absent. Kay Scott addresses the Council. Total revenues for month ending May 31, 2019 are \$185,241.81. 11-month ending is \$1,802,933.24. Really good shape according to budget. \$437,000 above what was projected. Expenses for May were \$144,377.36. Net income of \$38,373.88 for month of May. Good standing for 11-month ending. Net profit of \$74,218.42. Mayor asks for any questions. None.
7. BUSINESS PREVIOUSLY CONSIDERED  

Tommy Walker asks about the rezoning ordinance that was tabled. Mayor Watkins states got hung up in litigation. Can't do the rezoning per attorney.
8. BUSINESS NOT PREVIOUSLY CONSIDERED.
  - A. CONSIDER AND ACT TO APPROVE QUOTE FROM MCALESTER STRIPING & ASPHALT CO IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2668.00 FOR YELLOW LINES STRIPING ON MAIN STREET. Ed Klink addresses council. Will start off at highway and goes to Fillmore. The person got quote from may not have the experience or a machine that is capable of credible paint job. If passed would ask operator of machine to give us a demonstration prior to acceptance of bid. Would only be passed if the painter insures and shows he is capable. Connie Poole asks if he has a machine. Tommy Walker says he has spoken to him asked about a leveler on machine, he does not have one. Painter says he can do it without leveler. Tommy agrees needs demonstration before bid accepted. Painter agreed to come out and give demonstration. Ed says we need to pay attention because last time they weren't cautious as you can see with yellow lines. Tommy told painter we needed sample. Connie Says we

definitely want to have a sample. Tommy thinks with what he is charging for a mile we could save up and get machine to do whole town. Ed suggests will get him down on s. main and get sample will only be passed as long as there is a sample. Connie asks if it will be from highway to Fillmore. Tommy says 1 mile. Mayor Watkins asks for a motion to pass with stipulation to get sample approved first. Tommy Walker makes motion. Jason Wagnon seconds motion. Mayor takes vote. Daulfin Bennett – yes, Jason Wagnon – yes, Connie Poole – yes, Tommy Walker – before voting Tommy says he asked what type of paint he was using and he wouldn't answer. Might be using cheaper paint that won't last. Tommy votes yes. Motion with stipulation for example of striping passes.

B. CONSIDER AND ACT TO APPROVE QUOTE FROM PERRY SURVEYING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3000 FOR PROFILING STREETS; BLAKE, MORRA AND BOCCI. Ed Klink addresses the Council. Trying to straighten up this area for long time. A hard rain will cause property damage. Thinks time to do something about it. Might be expensive, but least we can do. Proper thing to do. If passes will take it before engineers. Will get estimates and bring up at another meeting. Wants understood will be expensive, but saying doesn't exist is not a reasonable excuse. Mayor Watkins asks for a motion. Jason Wagnon makes a motion. Daulfin Bennett seconds the motion. Mayor Watkins takes a vote. Tommy Walker – yes, Connie Poole – yes, Jason Wagnon – yes, Daulfin Bennett – yes. Motion to have streets surveyed passes.

C. CONSIDER AND ACT TO APPROVE QUOTE FROM HODEMAN CONCRETE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3000 FOR BASKETBALL COURT AT CHOCTAW PARK. Ed Klink addresses council. Discussed on several occasions Choctaw Park is not being utilized because there is not a lot there. Planning on getting another swing set and improve over-all condition. Maybe slowly by will get done. Have to start somewhere. A properly poured concrete pad will be there a long time. Thinks would benefit that end of town. Tommy asks about bid where says City of Krebs will furnish ODOT – what does that mean? Ed says part we will furnish is the oil-based supplement that goes in first to make sure water is contained, and we don't have water rising up under the concrete pad. Explains a condition that can happen if water pushes up under the concrete after it freezes. We will do ½ of whatever he uses. Mayor Watkins asks for motion. Connie Poole makes motion. Daulfin Bennett seconds motion. Mayor Watkins asks for a vote. Tommy Walker – yes, Connie Poole – yes, Jason Wagnon – yes, Daulfin Bennett yes. Motion to use Hodeman Concrete for basketball court at Choctaw park passes.

10. COMMENTS FROM THE COUNCIL AND MAYOR. Connie Poole states animal control is doing an excellent job. Also, Julia is doing an excellent job with abatements. She says it is something that needed to be done and she is pursuing it the right way and getting it done. Tommy Walker states she is getting everybody not just certain people. Mayor Watkins agrees she has gone farther than any year we have had so far. Ed Klink says they have gone pretty far with insulation of new equipment for water and sewer plants. They have crossed in to territory they hadn't been in. Now have operational equipment that has not been operational in a long time. He says as a citizen of Krebs he'd like to thank the council. The Mayor thanked Ed for all he does.
