- A. MEETING CALLED TO ORDER by Mayor Tommy Ray Walker.
- B. ROLL CALL by W Kay Scott, City Treasurer. Tommy Walker – present, David Bailey – present, Jason Wagnon – present, Connie Poole – Absent, Dan Heathcock – present.
- C. DISCUSS AND ACT TO GO INTO EXECUTIVE SESSION PURSUANT TO OKLAHOMA STATE STATUTE TITLE 25 SECTION 307 (B) (2) TO DISCUSS NEGOTIATIONS WITH KREBS POLICE OFFICER'S 3 YEAR FRATERNAL ORDER OF POLICE CONTRACT FOR 2023 THROUGH 2026. Mayor Walker asked for a motion. Dan Heathcock made the motion to go into executive session. Jason Wagnon seconded the motion. Mayor Walker called for a vote.
