 Mayor Bobby Watkins called the meeting to order.
- ROLL CALL.

- 3. PRAYER AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE. David Bailey led the prayer.
- 4. DISCUSS AND ACT TO APPROVE THE MINUTES OF THE JULY 20, 2021 COUNCIL MEETING. Mayor Watkins asks if there are any questions. Mayor Watkins asks for a motion to approve the minutes. Mr. Kern states that we show expenditures in excess of revenues of \$101,722.53. Mr. Kern states that we transferred \$75,000.00 to the Krebs Utility Authority. Mr. Kern states that in July we had three payroll and it only happens every 6 months, also we had about \$12,000 in insurance. Mr. Kern asks if there are any questions.

 Mayor Watkins states that this the cost to upgrade the backhoe and it needs a lot of repairs. Mayor Watkins states that we can fix this one instead of buying a new one this year.

 Tommy Walker asks if this is the oldest one. Billy Robinson states that this is the 91-year model. Mayor Watkins states that we need this to help with water leaks. Mr. Nelms states that he has a lot of training. Mayor Watkins asks what that will bring the roster up to now. Mr. Nelms states 16. Mayor Watkins asks for motion to approve. Mr. Nelms states that the low pressure one is not keeping up with today's vehicles. Mr. Nelms states that this one is about 4 years old. Mayor Watkins calls for a motion.
