Mike states we are right on budget for the revenue. The expenses for the month of November were \$109,116.87. The month of November we had a loss of \$15,620.58. Mike states that we had a lot of repairs for the month in total of \$24,000.00. The year to date is \$72,000.00 and we are on budget. The five months ending November the expenses were \$461,268.79. We are showing a profit of \$32,291.31. Mike states that the water and sewer rates are going to increase and that will help get the revenue up. Mike asks if there are any questions.
