ORDINANCE 17-03

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 91-2

AN INCLUSION FOR SECTION 1 – SEWER CONNECTIONS, ITEM 6 AN ADDENDUM TO SECTION 201 – MANDATORY SEWER CONNECTIONS.

Inclusion: Ordinance 91-2 Section 1 – Sewer Connections, Item 6.

Any building within the City of Krebs used as a place of residency regardless of the source of Potable Water will be required to connect to the City Sanitary Sewer System. The resident will be required to reimburse the city for the cost of sewer water treatment at the same level as a resident using the municipal water treatment source. If such residency is currently utilizing another source of approved sewer water treatment, the resident must show proof of such a system and allow periodical inspection of said system.

Addendum: Ordinance 91-2 Section 201 – Mandatory Sewer Connections.

Any building, shed, or structure to be utilized as a place of human occupancy must be connected to the Municipal Waste Water System. Potable Water treatment and proper Waste Water treatment are paramount elements in preserving the state of sanitation required to ensure Public Health and Safety. Compliance with this action can be afforded through the use of a recognized. City inspected and City approved customer owned waste water treatment system.

Emergency Clause: An immediate necessity existing for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, AN EMERGENCY is hereby declared to exist by reason of which this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication.
