consumption. As a precaution, it is advised that the consumers of this water system bring the
water to a full, rolling boil for at least one minute before drinking, consumption, food
preparation, baby formula preparation, dish washing, tooth brushing, ice making, wound care,
and bathing infants who may ingest bath water. Alternatively, bottled water or another
acceptable water source may be used.
Important Note: This precautionary boil advisory is not related to the Coronavirus Disease (COVID-
19) pandemic, and it is important to continue to wash your hands during the precautionary boil advisory.
If soap and water are not available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer containing at least 60% alcohol.
Comments: Due to the severe storm system that passed through Monday night, our basement was flooded and most of our pumping equipment was submerged.
We are currently running on backup equipment and will have low pressure for the next few days until the pumps are returned from the motor rebuild shop.
