RESOLUTION OF PROJECT SPONSORSHIP

## TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM APPLICATION AND MAINTENANCE COMMITMENT

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE ELIGIBILITY OF THE CITY OF KREBS TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE OKLAHOMA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR USE OF TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM FUNDS SET FORTH BY MAP-21 FOR THE ELECTRIC AVENUE SIDEWALK IN KREBS AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR BOBBY WATKINS TO SIGN THIS APPLICATION.

Whereas, the <u>City of Krebs</u> Oklahoma, is submitting an application to the Oklahoma Department of Transportation for transportation alternatives program funds in the amount of \$93,000.00 set forth by MAP-21 and as outlined in ODOT's transportation alternatives program guidance & application packet for 2017 and 2018; and

Whereas, the <u>City of Krebs</u>, Oklahoma, is participating as an eligible project sponsor in the Oklahoma Department of Transportation's transportation alternatives program set forth by MAP-21; and

Whereas, federal monies are available under a transportation alternatives program set forth by MAP- 21, administered by the state of Oklahoma, Department of Transportation, for the purpose of creating and promoting the planning and development of active transportation facilities and programs in Oklahoma; and

Whereas, the <u>City of Krebs</u>, Oklahoma, acknowledges availability of the required local match of no less than 20%; and,

Whereas, after appropriate public input and due consideration, the governing body of <u>Krebs</u>, Oklahoma, has recommended that an application be submitted to the state of Oklahoma for the project.

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the governing body of the <u>City of Krebs</u>, Oklahoma:

Section 1. That the <u>City of Krebs</u>, Oklahoma, does hereby authorize the <u>Mayor</u> to submit an application to the Oklahoma Department of Transportation for transportation alternatives program funds set forth by MAP-21 on behalf of the citizens of <u>Krebs</u>, Oklahoma.

Section 2. That the <u>City of Krebs</u>, Oklahoma, hereby assures the Oklahoma Department of Transportation that sufficient funding for the <u>Electric Avenue Sidewalk</u> is available.

Section 3. That the <u>City of Krebs</u>, Oklahoma, hereby assures the Oklahoma Department of Transportation that sufficient funding for the operation and maintenance of the <a href="mailto:sproject name">sproject name</a> will be available for the life of the project.

Section 4. That the <u>City of Krebs</u>, Oklahoma, hereby assures the Oklahoma Department of Transportation that the <u>City of Krebs</u>, Oklahoma, will have title or permanent easement to the <u>Electric Avenue Sidewalk</u> by the time of project letting, if necessary.

Section 5. That the chief project sponsor of <u>Krebs</u>, Oklahoma, is authorized to sign the application to the Oklahoma Department of Transportation for transportation alternatives program funds set forth by MAP-21 on behalf of the citizens of <u>Krebs</u>, Oklahoma. The chief project sponsor is also authorized to submit additional information as may be required and act as the official representative of the City of Krebs in this and subsequent related activities.
